


What to do when there's nothing to update






Runners (and other reasons to panic)

Most damning feedback:

'We weren't being updated on what was going on'

Examples of [null] to update:

- I can't protect you from that Dane axe
- I'll defend you against that spearman
- We're still fighting

Examples of [null] to update:

- Someone else needs to do [task]
- I'm on it, so you can stop spending CPU thinking about it
- 'Your' task is finished but there's still work to do for the whole team

The power of a war cry



You can't work at 100% of your capacity all the time

But sometimes you can rally the troops for an extra push
